CHAPTER 3 Standard Sheets & Cells

Introduction

A **STANDARD SHEET** is a partially to fully detailed sheet requiring minimal editing. These sheets should be used whenever possible. The standard sheets currently used by the Bridge Program are located on the server. An alphabetical listing of the standard sheets is included in Appendix A.

A **CELL** is a collection of elements that have been grouped together to form a symbol, pattern, or picture. A cell is generally text and/or graphic elements that are used repeatedly. Cells are stored in a **CELL LIBRARY**.

The cells currently used by the Bridge Program are stored in the **BRIDGE_V8.CEL** cell library located on the server. The majority of bridge cells are placed at the same scale as the sheet cell, while the remainder of cells are placed at a 1:1 scale. Some cells will require editing. Cell status must be dropped to perform this editing. An alphabetical listing of the cells within the cell library is included in Appendix B.

Use of the standard sheets and cells helps provide uniform details throughout the Bridge Program.
